I Quadrimestre:

Unit 11: Look to the future.

Grammar: Will; adverbs of manner;

Vocabulary: Ecology;

Functions: making predictions; giving opinions.

Unit 12: Have you tried....?

Grammar: Present perfect with ever/never; present perfect with just/already/yet; been/gone; Echo questions;

Vocabulary: Health and fitness, sport; parts of the body;

Functions: talking about personal experiences; Expressing interest.

Unit 13: A new start.

Grammar: Modal verbs: should, must, can; reflexive pronouns;

Vocabulary: Styles and accessories;

Functions: Giving advice; talking about obligation; talking about prohibition; Agreeing and disagreeing.

II Quadrimestre:

Unit 14: Hard work.

Grammar: Verb patterns; Have to;

Vocabulary: Jobs and work

Functions: talking about obligation and lack of obligation; Describing a job; talking and leaving messages.

Unit 15: Against the law.

Grammar: Past simple vs past continuous; defining relative clauses;

Vocabulary: Crime;

Functions: talking about what was happening; Giving and justifying opinions;

Unit 16: It's a disaster!

Grammar: Will, may and might for predictions; Future forms – revision; First conditional;

Functions: making predictions; Giving a presentation.

Unit 17: Body beautiful.

Grammar: Articles; past perfect;
